Driving Directions and Parking:	<i>To School from Suggested Hotel:</i> Turn left onto 6 th St N. Turn right onto N 18 th Ave. Turn left to merge onto US-82 W. Take the Main St. exit toward Downtown/Columbus. (Take sharp left at end of ramp). Traveling east on Main Street, turn right at the MS University for Women sign. This will bring you up to College Street with the Main Gate of MUW across the Street. Do not go through the Main Gate. You will turn left at this stop sign. Now you are traveling east on College Street. A black wrought iron fence will be alongside you. When this fence ends, you will be sitting at a four-way stop. Turn right at this stop sign. Then take your first gate in to the right. As you come through the gate, swing right. The street will fork on you a few feet away, but you bear to the right. You will end up in a big square parking lot. You are now behind Shattuck Hall. Walk around the right side of the building by the herb gardens and to the front of the building to enter.
Suggested Airport(s) for Arrival:	Golden Triangle Regional Airport (GTR)
Suggested Ground Transportation:	The area does not have reliable cab service so a rental car is the best solution. The airport is about 15 minutes from the city of Columbus and the campus of MUW. AVIS, Hertz, and Enterprise are all available at the GTR airport.

Attendees are permitted to wear the Summer Institutes coat or bring their own. • Long pants such as chef pants, cargo pants, chinos, etc. <i>No shorts are allowed in the kitchen.</i> • Appropriate close-toed, non-slip shoes. <i>No sandals are allowed in the kitchen.</i> <p>Classroom or offsite activities will not require the standard uniform. Casual attire is acceptable for work outside of kitchen and lab sessions.</p>
