Driving Directions and Parking:	<p>Traveling on I-77 heading south: Take highway 277 toward Columbia, this road becomes Bull Street. Travel approximately 9 blocks and turn right onto Gervais Street. Drive approximately 6 blocks and turn left onto Park street. The Hilton will be on your right on the corner of Park street and Senate street.</p> <p>Traveling on I-20 heading east Take Highway 1, exit 58, towards Columbia: Travel on Hwy 1 for approximately 9 miles, crossing the river into the downtown area. Highway 1 becomes Gervais Street. Turn right onto Park street. The Hilton will be on your right on the corner of Park street and Senate street.</p> <p>Traveling on I-20 heading west. Take highway 277 towards Columbia, this road becomes Bull Street. Travel approximately 9 blocks and turn right onto Gervais Street and travel approximately 6 blocks. Turn left onto Park street. The Hilton will be on your right on the corner of Park street and Senate street.</p> <p>Traveling on I-26, either direction (East or West) Take highway 1, exit 111, to Columbia Travel on Highway 1 for approximately 5 miles, crossing the river into the downtown area. Highway 1 becomes Gervais Street Turn right onto Park street. The Hilton will be on your right on the corner of Park street and Senate street.</p> <p>*If you are driving in daily please contact SIEvents@restaurant.org to be connected to host site staff for a parking pass in the Pendleton Street Garage. If you are staying in a nearby hotel, we will provide transportation and no parking pass will be required.</p> <p>Walking Directions from Hotel: McCutchen House is on the Horseshoe at USC From the Hilton, take Park street to Pendleton Street. Take a left and walk past the State House complex, turning right onto Sumter Street. The Historic USC Horseshoe is approximately 100 yards on the left hand side of Sumter Street. Enter the gates of the Horseshoe and the McCutchen House is the third building on the left. For the reception/dinner on Sunday we will be in the McCutchen House. The walking time is less than 15 minutes from the hotel.</p>
